MEASURES BALLOT

Vote by darkening the oval next to the word "YES" or "NO" following the explanation of each measure.

Constitutional Measure No. 1

(Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 4007, 2025 Session Laws, Ch. 615)

This constitutional measure would amend and reenact section 9 of article III and section 16 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota, relating to requiring each resolution adopted by the legislative assembly proposing a constitutional amendment and each initiative petition and measure proposing a constitutional amendment be comprised of a single subject. The proposed amendment is summarized as follows: constitutional amendments would be limited to one subject. The Secretary of State shall not approve an initiative petition for circulation if the Secretary determines that the proposed amendment comprises more than one subject. Additionally, the legislative assembly is required to limit proposed amendments to the constitution to one subject.

The estimated fiscal impact of this measure is none.

<p style="text-align: center;">Minot City Measure No. 1</p> <p>Shall the City of Minot amend its Minot Code of Ordinances to adopt an additional one-half percent (1/2%) tax on gross receipts of retailers from all sales at retail and dedicate the tax to the Minot Park District to provide general funds for the operation of the Park District and to provide funding for future capital improvement projects of the Park District. Upon approval of the one-half percent (1/2%) sales tax the Park District shall reduce the property tax assessment cap on its general fund mills from 38 mills to 26 mills, which cap shall sunset June 30, 2046. The one-half percent (1/2%) sales and use tax shall remain in effect indefinitely unless repealed or amended in accordance with the Minot Code of Ordinances, but in no instance shall the tax be repealed or amended before June 30, 2046.
