Special Statewide Election Held June 28, 1960

We, the undersigned members of the State Board of Canvassers met in the office of the Secretary of State on the eighteenth day of July, 1960, for the purpose of canvassing the votes cast in the several precincts and counties of the State of North Dakota in the Special Statewide Election held on June 28, 1960 for the election of a United States Senator for the residue of the term to which the Honorable William Danger was elected, ending the First Monday in January A.D. 1965. And that the attached abstract is a correct tabulation of the votes, certified by the several County Auditors of the State from which it appears that Quentin Burdick a Democrat of Fargo in Cass County, North Dakota, having received the greater number of votes, was duly elected as shown by the figures and total therein set forth.
