PETITION TITLE

This initiated measure would repeal two sections of the North Dakota Criminal Code that prohibit businesses from operating between the hours of midnight and noon on Sunday and would repeal a section that provides an exception for 39 specified businesses during those hours. The measure also would amend a section of law by removing the prohibition on contracts that require a business to open on Sunday, effective for contracts made on or after January 1, 2019.

FULL TEXT OF THE MEASURE

IF MATERIAL IS UNDERSCORED, IT IS NEW MATERIAL WHICH IS BEING ADDED. IF MATERIAL IS OVERSTRUCK BY DASHES, THE MATERIAL IS BEING DELETED. IF MATERIAL IS NOT UNDERSCORED OR OVERSTRUCK, THE MATERIAL IS EXISTING LAW THAT IS NOT BEING CHANGED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. REPEAL. Sections 12.1-30-01, 12.1-30-02, and 12.1-30-03 of the North Dakota Century Code are repealed.

SECTION 2. Amendment. Section 12.1-30-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

12.1-30-04. Retail business leases or agreements - Penalty.

A retail business may not be required to be open on Sunday as a part of a lease agreement, franchise agreement, or any other contractual arrangement made and executed prior to January 1, 2019. A violation of this section is a class A misdemeanor.

INSTRUCTIONS TO PETITION SIGNERS

You are being asked to sign a petition. You must be a qualified elector. This means you are eighteen years old, you have lived in North Dakota thirty days, and you are a United States citizen. All signers shall also legibly print their name, complete residential address or rural route or general delivery address, and the date of signing on the petition. Every qualified elector signing a petition must do so in the presence of the individual circulating the petition.
