These measures are being submitted to the voters of North Dakota for their approval or rejection. Vote by darkening the oval either opposite the word "YES" or "NO" following the explanation of each measure.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;">Constitutional Measure No. 1 (Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 4006, 2011 Session Laws, Ch. 520)</p> <p>This constitutional measure would repeal section 6 of Article X of the North Dakota Constitution. <p style="text-align: center;">Initiated Constitutional Measure No. 3</p> <p>BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NORTH DAKOTA:</p> <p>SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 29 of Article XI of the North Dakota Constitution is created and enacted as follows:</p> <p><u>Section 29. The right of farmers and ranchers to engage in modern farming and ranching practices shall be forever guaranteed in this state. No law shall be enacted which abridges the right of farmers and ranchers to employ agricultural technology, modern livestock production and ranching practices.</u></p> <p><input type="radio"/> Yes - means you approve the measure stated above.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> No - means you reject the measure stated above.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Initiated Statutory Measure No. 5</p> <p>This initiated statutory measure would create section 36-21.1-02.1 of the North Dakota Century Code. This measure would make it a class C felony for an individual to maliciously and intentionally harm a living dog, cat or horse and provide a court with certain sentencing options. The measure would not apply to production agriculture, or to lawful activities of hunters and trappers, licensed veterinarians, scientific researchers, or to individuals engaged in lawful defense of life or property.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Yes - means you approve the measure summarized above.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> No - means you reject the measure summarized above.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Bismarck City Measure No. 1</p> <p>Shall Article 3 of the Home Rule Charter for the City of Bismarck be amended:</p> <p>1. City Lodging and Restaurant Tax. To create and enact a new section 18a-d to impose an additional lodging and restaurant tax of one and one half percent of those gross receipts which are taxed pursuant to NDCC Section 40-57.3-01.1 on the leasing or renting of hotel, motel, or tourist court accommodations within the city and upon the gross receipts of a restaurant from any sales of prepared food or beverages to begin on January 1, 2013, to be used only for the 2013 Civic Center Expansion and Renovation Project and to be discontinued on December 31, 2033; and</p> <p>2. City Lodging Tax. To create and enact a new section 19a-d to impose an additional lodging tax of one percent of those gross receipts which are taxed pursuant to NDCC Section 40-57.3-01 upon the leasing or renting of hotel, motel, or tourist court accommodations within the city to begin on January 1, 2013, to be used only for the 2013 Civic Center Expansion and Renovation Project and to be discontinued on December 31, 2033; and</p> <p>3. To remove redundant language in existing section 17a-f, to remove expired language in existing section 17a-f relating to previously approved and completed projects, to add language required by and consistent with recent changes in state law regarding the streamlined sales tax and to re-number sections as appropriate.</p> <p>A "yes" vote means that you approve these proposed amendments to the Home Rule Charter for the City of Bismarck as published in the Bismarck Tribune.</p> <p>A "no" vote means that you reject these proposed amendments to the Home Rule Charter for the City of Bismarck as published in the Bismarck Tribune.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Yes</p> <p><input type="radio"/> No</p>
