This measure would prohibit the appointment of a member of the Legislative Assembly to a state office for which the compensation was increased in an amount greater than any general legislative increase provided to full-time state employees during the member's term of office.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> <b>YES</b> - means you approve the measure as summarized above.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> <b>NO</b> - means you reject the measure as summarized above.</p> <hr/> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Initiated Constitutional Measure No. 2</b></p> <p>This initiated constitutional measure would amend sections 1, 4, 14, 15, and 16 of Article X of the North Dakota Constitution and repeal sections 5, 6, 7, 9, and 10 of that same article, eliminating property taxes, poll taxes, and acreage taxes, effective January 1, 2012. The right to act or refuse to act in a manner motivated by a sincerely held religious belief may not be burdened unless the government proves it has a compelling governmental interest in infringing the specific act or refusal to act and has used the least restrictive means to further that interest.
