MEASURES BALLOT	Constitutional Measure No. 3 (HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3047, 2013 SESSION LAWS, CH. 521)	COUNTY MEASURE No. 1 COUNTY WIDE SALES TAX
<p style="text-align: center;">Constitutional Measure No. 1 (SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 4009, 2013 SESSION LAWS, CH. 519)</p> <p>This constitutional measure would create and enact a new section to Article I of the North Dakota Constitution stating, "The inalienable right to life of every human being at any stage of development must be recognized and protected."</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Yes - means you approve the measure stated above.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> No - means you reject the measure stated above.</p>	<p>This constitutional measure would create and enact a new section to Article VIII of the North Dakota Constitution creating a three-member commission of higher education, effective July 1, 2015, with full executive responsibility for the management and operation of the North Dakota university system. The measure would repeal Section 6 of Article VIII of the Constitution relating to the current eight-member state board of higher education. Members of the new commission would be appointed by the Governor to four year terms from a list of nominees provided by a special committee, and would be subject to confirmation by the Senate. One of the commissioners must possess leadership experience in a private sector business, industry, or service and one member, at the time of appointment, must hold a professional position within the higher education sector. The commissioners could be reappointed to three consecutive terms.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Yes - means you approve the measure summarized above.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> No - means you reject the measure summarized above.</p>	<p>The Hettinger County Board of County Commissioners have adopted an ordinance that would impose \$.005/dollar sales tax (1/2 cent) on all taxable sales within Hettinger County. The money raised by the tax is designated to be used first to fund law enforcement and related activities, and any money not used for those purposes would be used for emergency services. <p style="text-align: center;">Constitutional Measure No. 2 (HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3006, 2013 SESSION LAWS, CH. 520)</p> <p>This constitutional measure would create and enact a new section to Article X of the North Dakota Constitution stating, "The state and any county, township, city, or any other political subdivision of the state may not impose any mortgage taxes or any sales or transfer taxes on the mortgage or transfer of real property."</p> <p><input type="radio"/> Yes - means you approve the measure stated above.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> No - means you reject the measure stated above.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Constitutional Measure No. 4 (HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3011, SESSION LAWS, CH. 522)</p> <p>This constitutional measure would amend and reenact section 2 of Article III of the North Dakota Constitution. This measure would require that initiated measures that are estimated to have a significant fiscal impact must be placed on the general election ballot.
