

## LOGIC AND ACCURACY TESTING

The logic and accuracy testing of the election programming and equipment is one of the most important pre-election steps that as a county auditor you must perform. The testing hits at the very hearth of what we do, providing honest, fair, and accurate tallies of votes cast by voters. Most of you have done this before, some may have relied on the test decks sent to you by the programmer and others have designed their own test decks.

What we want to do is walk you through how to do the testing one more time before we have to scramble to put together our test decks. If we plan it out in advance it is a lot easier to cover all the bases and not have our programming blow up on Election Day!

**First of all, do not rely on the test deck sent to you from the programmer, it doesn't test everything, and of course it works, they used it to test their programming before sending it to you!** We want to design a test deck that assures us and the public that a vote cast will be counted correctly. On a ballot with only one race with just a few candidates this is easy, but as you get multiple candidates and rotations it gets more difficult.

You will have two and possibly three pieces of equipment in this election, the M100 Scanner, AutoMark, and some counties may have the Central Count 650. You will need to test all the equipment to make sure it works on Election Day. You will also need to test the Election Reporting Manager that you will put on your PC and the uplink to the state database.

### PRIMARY ELECTION

The election in June is the Primary Election – you know that – but there are some differences in how the system reports numbers in the Primary vs. General Elections. The printouts that you will get off the M100 are fairly straightforward. You will get a printout showing all the races for the Republican primary, Democratic primary, statewide non-partisan candidates, judicial district candidates, and then the county, city, school district, and measures races.

When you upload the information to your ERM system and look at the numbers they show the ballots by the ballot types. To make you familiar with how the report works, here are some sample numbers from a 2004 Primary Election from the ERM system:

Total Ballots Cast	13,808
Total Republican Ballots	6,864
Total Democrat Ballots	6,046
Non Partisan Ballots	<u>898</u>
Total	13,808

The system also tells you how many Cross Over Votes, in this Primary Election there were 262 – these were people who may have voted in BOTH the Republican or Democratic Primary Election – with the M100 this is usually absentee votes because the voters that show up at the precinct have the opportunity to correct their ballot – you could have some people who vote in person who say to just accept their ballot that way, but that is unusual.

All of the Republican county wide candidate races must total 6,864 and all of the Democratic county wide races must total 6,046. All other races that are county wide must total 13,808. Districts of less than the whole county will have their own totals, such as legislative, city, and school districts.

These are some examples from the 2004 Primary Election.

Total Republican ballots = 6,864, Democrat ballots = 6,046, and total ballots = 13,808

## DESIGNING THE TEST DECK

In designing your test deck you want to make sure that you test every candidate in every race, including write-in spots on the ballot. You also want to test over votes, under votes, cross over votes, and one important situation – whether the M100 will accept a ballot without a party vote! We ran into the situation one Primary Election where the M100 would not accept a ballot if there were no votes in either of the two parties on the ballot – to adjust we had to have voters mark write-in votes. Been there, done that, don't want to do it again.

The official test is the Tuesday before the election, go into that test with confidence that the systems are going to work, in other words, by that date have the equipment and programs tested.

You must test each ballot style. For instance, if you have a precinct with more than one ballot style, you must test each ballot style.

Tests for an office can be real simple such as the test for a single office shown below:

This is testing all the possible spots on the ballot by giving them different vote totals. It is easiest to set up tests for each precinct by first determining how many ballots you are going to need for the test. In this case you would need 8 ballots. Make up an edit list as you are preparing the test ballots - a spreadsheet is helpful but not essential - you can do the same thing on a copy of a ballot usually quicker and easier but the spreadsheet is handy for totaling up the precincts.

What gets complicated is when you add all the races for a precinct. You can do this on spreadsheet, but it is usually easier to start out with the ballot of each ballot style and mark on the ballot how many votes you want to fill in for each candidate. See the ballot for the last Primary Election in Precinct 09-22-04-02. **Example A**

This is an easy way to determine how you want to do your votes – you can do a lot of testing on each ballot. For instance, go through and mark the first candidate on every race on the first ballot (except the second political party). On the second and third ballot go through and mark the second candidate on every race (which may be a write in vote). The fourth through sixth ballot mark the third place candidate (which may be write in votes or over votes). Usually by the 7<sup>th</sup> ballot you are into the second political party. This process continues until you have completed the test deck for the precinct. How many ballots does this take – in the case of our last Primary Election – a lot!

Normally on a Primary Ballot you can get by with about 15 ballots per ballot style. Marking ballots is not fun, but the further you get into the test the fewer marks you need to make on the ballot. Throw in a blank ballot and any other rouge ballot you can think of just to try to trip up the system. If an error is going to appear, make it appear in the testing!

You can use different style spreadsheets to keep track of your tests; included are samples for a Primary Election (**Example B**) for a precinct and a spreadsheet from our last General Election (**Example C**). The nice thing about the General Election spreadsheet is we have handy totals for checking the results.

## **HOW TO DO THE TEST**

Sorry folks, you have to do the work. Test every machine and every program card. Test your upload to the PC and to the State – be comfortable that everything is going to work on Election Day! Start as soon as you have ballots and program cards so that if you find an error there is time to get it corrected before your official test.

### **M100**

To test your program card you need to put it into the scanner, run the ballots through, close your precinct, check your total tape against your check totals for that precinct, remove the card and upload it your PC. Once you have all your cards loaded into the PC print your abstract and check it against the check totals that you prepared. In this process you will most likely find that you made some errors in either creating your test deck or your check totals – now is the time to get that all straightened out before the public test!

Test for the unusual – will the M100 accept a blank ballot, how about a ballot without a party vote, do write-in ballots drop into the correct bin, does the diverter work, does the printer print clearly – the more you test the more you learn about the equipment and the programming and the more comfortable you'll feel.

We also test our backup cards – we have two backup cards for every 10 precincts just in case one of the precinct cards does not work on Election Day.

Once you are done with the testing you need to put the program card back into the M100 to clear out the test ballots to get ready for the public test. For the public test we usually explain the testing procedures, run the ballots through the M100, print our totals tape, compare it to the check figures, clear the card and put the seal on the card slot. The M100 is now ready to go to the precinct.

Sometimes you use a lot of tape while testing the M100 – make sure you have enough paper left on the printer roll before you send the M100 to the precinct – it is just one less thing you and the election board has to worry about on Election Day!

### **AutoMark**

We are all in the same boat on this one – no one in this state has used these before so we don't have any established procedures, however:

One way to test the AutoMark is to create your test deck on the AutoMark – you should be done by Christmas. A faster way would be to put some of your test ballots (one at a time, of course) into the AutoMark and see if it comes up with the correct candidates, both on the screen and audibly. You can print a test ballot that will fill in all the ovals and print the candidate's name. You can also print a couple of your test ballots to make sure that it is printing the ovals for the correct candidate. The other test you should do is listening to the instructions and candidate names to make sure the recording is clear and names are pronounced correctly.
